CLAUSE 1

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

It also offers customized solutions in luminaires and IOT technology, Business Consulting, Basic & Advance Engineering, Project Reporting & Management. Integrate technology in education sector in a way that we are able to bridge the gap between the needs and means available to students. This will also help to prepare better and more employable workforce for industry.

LNCT Group of Colleges has emerged as one of the Best Engineering College in Bhopal with its state-of-art facility and its expertise in engineering education. The brand has a strong motivation towards innovation in curriculum implementation. It further aspires to be a part of education revolution in Technical education, impacting futuristic technologies in Indian framework. In this process it aims to be one of the finest providers of technical education in India.

This MOU is to establish collaboration between LNCT Group of Colleges and Aartech Solonics for the purpose of promoting Industry Academic Collaboration.

7. Incubation consulting and support will be offered that is agreed mutually.

D. LNCT Group of Colleges Agrees:

1. To provide the details of students who are ready to be part of this program. LNCT Group of Colleges would also help in shortlisting the students.
2. To provide a project coordinator, it will be a faculty. The project coordinator would be a SPOC for Aartech Solonics.
3. To provide the well-defined escalation matrix to resolve conflicts amicably.
4. To provide office space with internet connection for the students to work on project.

II. Mutual Covenants

2. In case of any disagreement between the Parties in respect of any matter, directly or indirectly, connected to this Agreement then the same shall be resolved amicably by negotiations and /or conciliation between the Parties.

3. Both the parties agree to have explicit clearance in writing on all publicity/advertisement's material before publication in any form of media.

4. Both the Parties shall be responsible to provide each other with complete, accurate, timely and relevant information and to carry out any other obligations to run the program successfully. In addition, both the Parties shall keep each other informed of any material developments or proposals relating to the said program, which may have a bearing on the engagements between the Parties.

5. It is agreed by both the Parties that with respect to the confidential information and IPRs they shall:

a. Protect the confidential information and IPRs in a reasonable and appropriate manner as prescribed under law and in accordance with the applicable professional standards.

b. Use confidential information and IPRs only to perform obligation under this arrangement; and

c. Reproduce confidential information and IPRs only as required to perform its obligations under this arrangement.

III. Representations and Warranties of Parties.

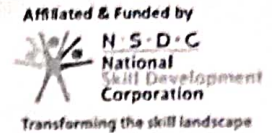

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- SOFCON INDIA has agreed to set up Incubation center for the training of Industrial Automation/Embedded System/ HVAC / Mechatronics / Data mining/Cloud Computing/PHP/SQL/IOT at the premises of LNCT GROUP-BHOPAL. Expenses incurred in setting up the lab will be borne by SOFCON INDIA & all the hardware (other than Lab infrastructure i.e Computers, UPS etc), software & accessories required for establishing this lab will remain sole property of SOFCON INDIA.
- LNCT GROUP-BHOPAL has agreed to provide Lab infrastructure (min 1500 sqft) covering training space, lighting, air-conditioning, furniture, computer hardware, UPS supply etc. required for Training Automation Lab. Thirty PC Nodes and a LCD Projector will be required to establish the lab. One System Administrator/ Incharge with Knowledge of computer hardware & software maintenance will be identified by LNCT GROUP to maintain the lab.
- Each Party will bear repair & Maintenance cost of their respective Infra (Hardware and Software)
- SOFCON INDIA has agreed to conduct Skill Development Training programs for 2nd , 3rd & final year students from EI, EC, EEE, IC, ME, CS Branches of LNCT GROUP-BHOPAL and Other Engineering colleges of Bhopal Region on following technologies INDUSTRIAL AUTOMATION, EMBEDDED SYSTEMS, VLSI, MATLAB, HVAC, MECHATRONICS, C & C++, JAVA, BIG DATA, HADOOP, ORACLE etc.. Sofcon has mentioned its MRP of various courses in the section "TRAINING COST", Selling Price of the Modules is to be decided by LNCT GROUP in mutual concern with SOFCON and the fee will be collected by LNCT GROUP only. For training of students from other insLNCTGROUP Putes Sofcon will only charge MRP proposed in section TRAINING COST.

Brief program to be conducted

Brief outline of the program to be conducted are as follows. Detailed contents to be covered will be finalized with mutual consent:

- EC/EX- Embedded system, Industrial Automation, VLSI, MATLAB.
- CS/IT- BIG DATA, C & C++, JAVA, ORACLE, HADOOP, CLOUD COMPUTING
- MECHANICAL- HVAC, Industrial Mechanical Engineering, MECHATRONICS
- Number of classes to be taken per Module (Min-15, Max-45).

TIME-LINE

- There will be an initial agreement for a period of 3 years, which shall be renewed in subsequent years as per the mutually agreed terms.

COMMITMENTS IN THE COLLABORATIVE PROGRAMME

- **LNCT GROUP-BHOPAL** will permit Minimum 100 Students of II, III, Final year from various Branches each year. Training will be of 04 Hrs duration per class. Sofcon can also conduct this training program on Saturdays & Sundays. Fee collection from the students will be the responsibility of LNCT GROUP. Fifty % advance before starting of the training program & balance on completion of each course.
- **M/s Sofcon** will arrange one FDP in each technology area every year free of charge.
- Once the student joins the course, fee will not be refunded under any circumstance.
- **SOFCON INDIA**, after the completion of training, will select the students for placement and will place them either at **SOFCON** or at **SOFCON'S** client companies on companies cost. Minimum 8% of students from LNCT GROUP will be selected for appointments after completion of training.
- Selected students will be placed as Project / Service / Application / Design Engineer (Automation, Embedded & Building Automation, HVAC) in automation companies, Automation Service providers, Automation consulting companies, Automation OEMs, Process & manufacturing industries, Electronics Companies, Robotics Companies, Commercial Real Estate, Energy, Facility Management companies, Malls, power plant, etc.
- The size of the companies may be small/medium/large enterprise, where students will work on core segment in PLC systems, SCADA Systems, Drives, Instrumentation, Control panels, Electrical & Electronics field Microcontroller - AVR, PIC, & Robotics, CCTV surveillance system, Electronics physical security system, Fire detection & Alarm system, Air condition and power plant maintenance. After gaining experience in these companies for 1-2 years, they will become eligible for companies like Siemens, Rockwell automation, GE Fanuc, Omron, Delta, Tata Honeywell, Johnson control, ABB & large Process & manufacturing giant.
- Selected student will get a minimum package upto maximum limit of 3. Lac depending upon their technical knowledge/skill of the student and company's size and structure.
- In order to gain the confidence of college and students, **SOFCON** will be flexible to sign a MOU for placement between student, **LNCT GROUP** and **SOFCON**,
- All trained Engineers can complete their projects at Sofcon lab and can get technical guidance free of cost on projects but the cost of components has to be borne by the students. Sofcon will not charge any cost for project development, student has to bear only the hardware cost
- 50 % payment has to be done in advance along with Service order AND balance payment on completion of the training. Cheque/DD to be drawn on '**SOFCON INDIA Pvt. Ltd**'.
- **LNCT GROUP** will not hire Automation Engineers employed by **SOFCON INDIA**.
- Each party agrees that the existence and terms of this MOU are confidential and shall not be disclosed to any third party.
- This MOU is only an expression of intent only and does not constitute a legally binding offer or contract. A binding agreement will arise only when all material terms have been set forth in a definitive agreement executed and delivered by authorized representatives of both the parties. All agreements, drafts, memorandum and other communications with respect to this MOU shall be considered only preliminary and shall have no legal effect unless subsequently incorporated into a definitive agreement or agreements.
